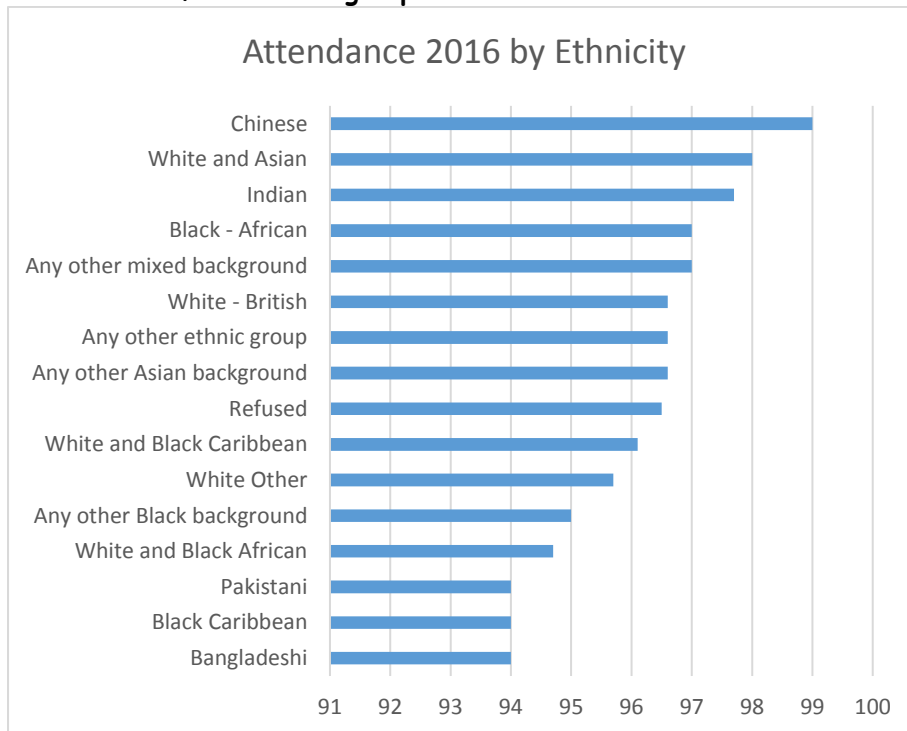

Attendance of vulnerable groups



- School target is for 97% attendance, 5 categories are meeting this or above, further 5 categories above 96%.
- There are 6 categories less than 96%, white other (the second highest number of children after white British -47) to be a focus for improvement next year.

- Average attendance between vulnerable groups and non-vulnerable groups are comparable. PP, medical needs and SEND fall below 96% and will continue to be a focus for support next year.

- EAL and those receiving Pupil Premium have similar attendance rates, slightly below the whole school data.
- SEND & Medical needs highest <95% attendance, although match the high attendance figures for the whole school. 56% of the SEND pupils have a medical need, which will affect both data sets. There is a need to focus on the few low attending pupils to provide support next year.
- Data is difficult to analyse as many children are included in more than 1 vulnerable group.

Action

Family support worker picks up all low attenders and meets with parents to offer parenting through group training and individual action plans.

To produce attendance policy in different languages for EAL children and their families.

Identify Low attending SEND/medical needs children for support.

Use medical plans to set targets for attendance with parents and support making appointments outside of school hours, where possible.
