

## Equality Objectives set 2017

- To tackle prejudice and promote understanding in relation to people with disabilities and individuals with protected characteristics, where that information is known.
  - To embrace the diversity of cultures with awareness of different religious practices and customs through a rich range of experience, both in and beyond the school.
  - Improve knowledge, skills and attitudes to enable pupils to appreciate and value difference and diversity, for example increasing understanding between pupils from different faith communities.
  - Not to tolerate bullying in any capacity: physical or mental whether personal or cyber and to provide suitable support to allow reporting and action to occur.
  - To ensure that all pupils are given similar opportunities with regards to after-school clubs, visits and activities.
  - To allow equal access to information for all parents.
  - To promote a physical environment that is accessible (with assistance as necessary) to all pupils, staff and visitors, having regard to the curriculum and fabric of the school.
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- Ensure effective use of Pupil Premium, closely monitoring its impact on disadvantaged pupils, to narrow the gap at all levels of reported data, especially where no other link to a protected characteristic is identified.
  - To narrow the gap between the attainment of EAL pupils in writing and Reading at the end of Key Stage 1.
  - To narrow the gap between the attainment of boys and girls in reading at the end of all reported stages.

These objectives are evidence through the school development plan and will be reviewed at the end of the year.
